To Network in Pune by PLHIV (NMP+)

We extend our thanks to NMP+ for providing us a platform to provide Care & Support services to People living with HIV/AIDS in Thane District through VIHAAN CARE & Support project funded by Alliance India. In the financial year 2018-2019 we were able to register 530 clients with us and provide 1590 services to these clients. 2860 lost to follow up clients were given home visits and peer counseling was provided to them to restart their ART treatment at the respective ART centres. 720 clients attended the Support group meetings organized at the ART centres by our representatives there. Chronic illness certificates, free bus pass, income and domicile certificates were also provided to PLHIV from Bhiwandi, Kalyan and Ulhasnagar ART centres.

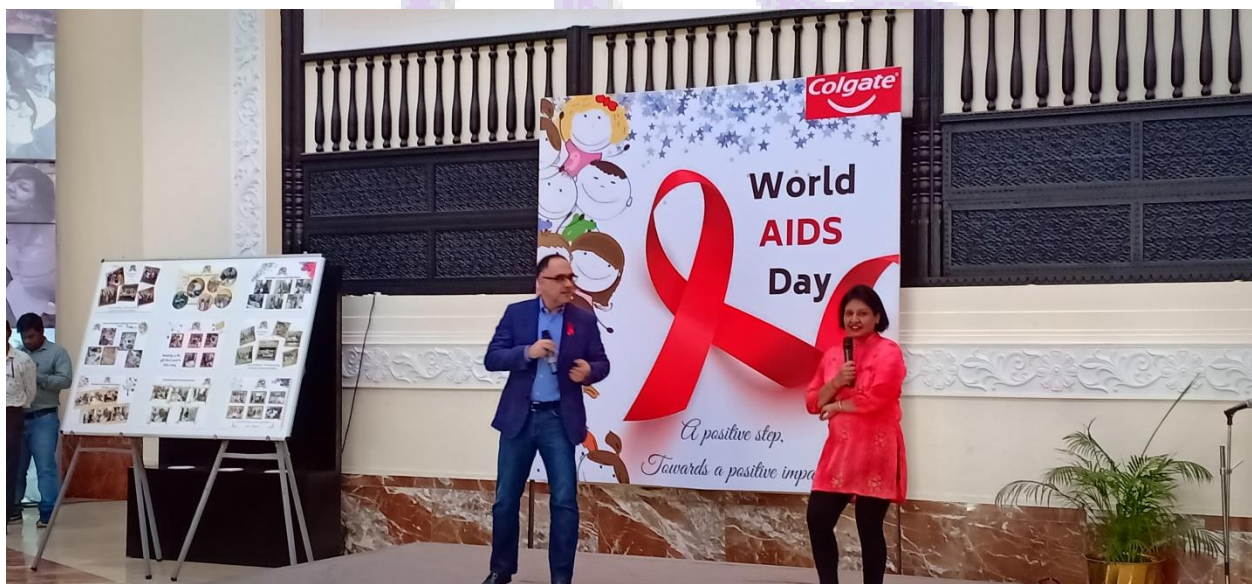
