

Executive Summary

Colgate-Palmolive (India) Ltd. and Network in Thane by people living with HIV/AIDS(NTP+) has been supporting the education and monthly Nutrition of 68 children and Education of 4 children from Thane District through Sponsorship program "A Positive Step" since 2008. These children are either single or double orphan and are living with HIV since birth.

There are 4 students in primary (class 1-4), 39 in secondary (class 5-10), 15 in higher secondary (class 11-12), 13 are pursuing Degree and 1 child is doing professional course. Out of these 72 children 68 of them collect their monthly Nutrition kit from Network in Thane by PLHIV(NTP+) office at Kalyan every month and Education support is provided to these children along with other 4 HIV affected children.

Other than Nutrition and Education support Parents/Caretakers and Children's meetings conducted at NTP+ Office, help in the grooming and Capacity building of these children. Topics covered during the meetings include Carrier Guidance, Life Skill Education, Leadership Development, Preparation for Exams and Drawing competition with these children. Higher secondary children are provided with Career guidance through the Mentorship program, another initiative by the company to help the children to choose a carrier according to their skills and abilities.

During the year 2022-2023 Company Volunteer involvement and one to one Mentorship meetings could not be conducted. However, mentees were free to consult their mentors on call for information and Guidance regarding Career development.

This year World Aids day was celebrated with the children on $1^{\rm st}$ December at Borivali, Mumbai. The children were taken to Borivali to enjoy Royal Circus on World Aids Day. The children were very happy as


they were able to move out of their homes and travel to Mumbai for the circus after a gap of 3 years post Covid. With the sponsors World Aids Day was celebrated virtually with the video recording of children's performance in different activities at NTP+ office. These activities were recorded and shared with the company sponsors during World Aids day. Gift hampers were also provided to every child and their wish fulfilled by their sponsors during the month of December. The children's wishes were fulfilled by their sponsors as per the wish tree provided by the children, a procedure followed by NTP+ and Colgate company every World Aids day.

Academics

Every child enrolled in the Positive Step program attends school either Public or Private for Education. These children come from poor families and many of them cannot afford education in Private or English medium schools. Due to Health-related issues they join schools near their area of residence. Their medium of education is usually Marathi or Hindi.

Monitoring Health.

As these children are born with HIV they face many health-related issues due to a weak immune system and need to monitor their health every month. These children have to follow strict treatment regime daily and have to meet their doctors at Government treatment centers every month for their monthly medicines. Their weight and height are checked on monthly basis. CD4 count is checked on half yearly basis and their viral load is checked on yearly basis. Apart from this if they have any opportunistic infections they are immediately put on medication and taken care of. Follow up of their treatment adherence and health progress is monitored by the Staff of NTP+ and by the doctors at the treatment centers during routine hospital visits by them. The nutrition support from Colgate company helps them to maintain good health and increase their immune system, preventing them from other opportunistic infections.

In the year 2022 Education Institutions for the children were started on 25th February 2022 and the children were happy to start offline Education again and meet their friends and teachers after a gap of 22 months. 

Monthly Nutrition support to these children by the Colgate company under the "Positive Step" program has helped to increase the attendance of these children at school as this support helps in maintaining good health and keeping away Opportunistic infections due to HIV infection in these children. This helps in improving the quality of life of these children.

Case Study



Asif Ansari, an orphan, living with HIV since birth was introduced to the "Positive Step" program in 2016. With little support from his aged grandparents living in the slums of Shanti Nagar at Bhiwandi he grew up with Education from a nearby Government school in Urdu medium. Before he joined the program he was removed from school as his caretakers were not able to pay his school fees. He was in the 5th standard at the time of his enrollment in our program. He was put on Anti-Retroviral Treatment (ART) by the


doctors at Thane Civil hospital when he was infected with TB in the year 2015. During his treatment he was introduced to NTP+ by the Health Promotors of NTP+ at Bhiwandi. After approval from Colgate company Asif was introduced in the program for Education and Nutrition support. He was in the 5th standard then. With frequent follow up sessions and meetings at NTP+ office Asif gained the confidence to look forward in life and Adhere to his treatment. With regular support from Colgate Company and proper counseling sessions by NTP+ staff he was able to cope up with the fear of HIV infection and focused on his Education. This year he is in his 10th Standard. He also takes care of his aged grandparents. He is thankful to Colgate company for the Education and Nutrition support for the last 7 years and helping in his overall development.





We were able to register with our organization during this year and provide them various need-based services through our outreach team.

Support Group

12 Support Group meetings conducted during the year with an attendance of 232 participants who were provided information on different topics covering ART adherence, Home Based Care, Life Skill Education, Positive Living, Diet and different Government Social Schemes.





Nutrition Support

Dry Ration support was provided to 1330 PLHIV with the help of our sponsors like Colgate Palmolive, Akshay Patra Foundation and Akshaya Shakti Welfare Association.

Life Skill Education

Life Skill Education and Capacity building training was provided to 72 Children. 4 CLHIV were provided Mentorship Support through our CSR support group.

Linkages to Social Schemes


To help needy PLHIV to get Financial support from the Government we were able to link 1634 PLHIV to various Government departments and provide them with Medical Certificates, Ration Card, Domicile Certificate, Income Certificate, Aadhar Card, Birth Certificates and Sanjay Gandhi Pension Schemes.

Health Services

Different Health Services like PAP Smear test, HIV test, Family Planning operation, TB Testing and treatment, CD4 Test, Viral Load Test, Hospital Admission and Lost to Follow up services was provided to 4200 PLHIV during the year.

In House Trainings

As part of the Care and Support project we were able to provide trainings and information on subjects like Home Based Care, Health and Hygiene, ART







Adherence, Need Based Counseling, Safe Sex practices and Positive living and Gender Equality.

NTP+ was able to provide different types of services to 8200 PLHIV from Thane District during the year and in a manner Motivate them to improve their Quality of Life.
